KEY SIGNAL OF PROGRESS

Multistakeholder Governance

- Established strong multi-stakeholder governance** through the PPI Compact (2019), facilitating collaboration among government, private sector, and NGOs.
- Supported policy breakthroughs like Governor's Decree 718/2017** for Essential Ecosystem Areas (KEE), protecting 8,000+ ha HCV/HCS area.
- Enhanced transparency** with deforestation alerts, fire prevention protocols, and joint monitoring systems.

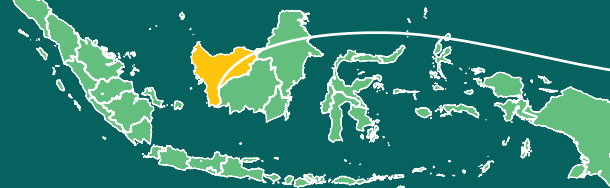
Business Practices Transformation

- Mobilized €5.7 million private investment** to scale landscape sustainability.
- Supported farmer legality (STDB)**, cooperative development, and traceable palm oil supply chains.
- Additional investment was catalyzed through IDH's facilitation, attracting new commitments for continuous support of the Compact, expanding the pipeline of jurisdictional investment.

Field Level Change

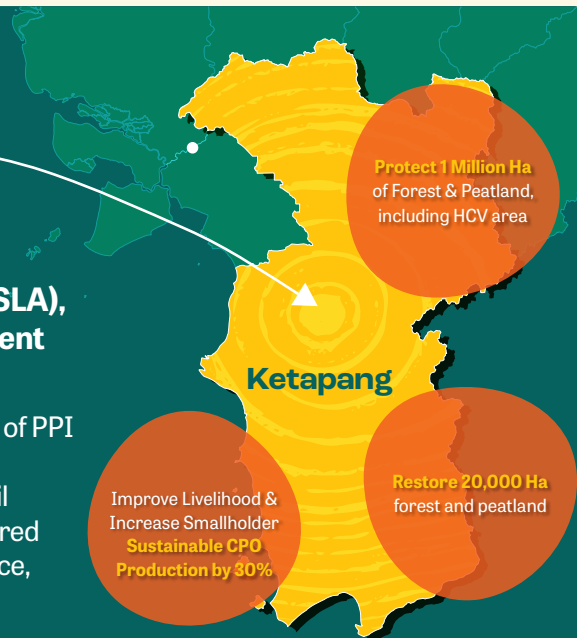
- Trained 3,700+ farmers** on Good Agricultural Practices and cooperative management.
- Mapped 4,000+ ha smallholder farms and achieved **zero fires (2022)** through integrated fire management.
- Strengthened livelihoods via agroforestry and sustainable wetland farming.

West Kalimantan



Through the Initiative for Sustainable Landscapes (ISLA), IDH's work in West Kalimantan has turned commitment into collective action.

In Ketapang, West Kalimantan, the establishment and operation of PPI Compact have strengthened multi-stakeholder governance and anchored collaboration across government, companies, and civil organizations. Over the past nine years, these efforts have delivered signals of real progress by transforming jurisdictional governance, reshaping business practices, and driving tangible change for smallholders.

-  **37,000+ ha forest protected** collaboration with BGA
-  **>4,000 ha farm area mapped for smallholders production** Smallholder farm mapping
-  **3,700+ farmers trained** on GAP, legality, cooperatives
-  **Operationalization of deforestation monitoring, covering 1 million ha of forest area** GAR project
-  **Zero concession fires (2022)** via integrated fire management
-  **Wildlife corridors established** linking HCV/HCS zones



Through BGA's Hutan Desa program, we learned which forest areas we can and cannot farm, helping us avoid planting in protected zones. BGA trained us in agroforestry and gave us free seedlings- many of which came from their own nursery. With help from IDH and BGA, our farmer group, Sumber Rejeki, also received training on RSPO standards. Thanks to these efforts, we've improved the way we grow oil palm, increased our yields, and now sell our harvest at better and more consistent prices."



MILESTONES

- 2017**  **SK 718/2017 established Essential Ecosystem Areas (KEE)** in Ketapang and Kayong Utara, creating a multi-stakeholder forum led by the Regent to safeguard HCV/HCS zones.
- 2019**  **The PPI Compact MoU was signed in Ketapang**, bringing together the District Government, IDH, and major palm oil companies, with a secretariat at Yayasan Mitra Pembangunan Ketapang.
- 2021**  **Traceability tools and risk-based onboarding were introduced**, including the rollout of **Koltiva** to improve transparency across smallholder supply chains.
- 2022**  **Zero fires were recorded in concession areas**, as integrated fire management and multi-stakeholder forums proved effective.
- 2023-2024**  **Compact activities strengthened monitoring and grievance systems**, the PPI Compact's capacity was strengthened in preparation for jurisdictional deforestation monitoring and fire-prevention protocols, with growing recognition from partners.
- 2025**  **The Compact prepares for scale-up**, focusing on institutionalizing monitoring systems, diversifying investment pipelines, and accelerating farmer pathways from STDB legality toward ISPO/RSPO certification.
